Updates on RVA757 Connects' 2022 Initiatives

- I-64 Gap
 - A public meeting will be held at the New Kent rest area on December 13 from 5-7
 - A federal grant announcement is expected soon.
- I-64 Innovation Corridor Bike-walk Trail Support
 - o Tom Cosgrove reported that he used RVA757 Connects' approved Bike Trail Plan to advance the Tidewater Trail Alliance BoAT's work. Thank You, Tom!
 - o Dr. Holsworth has been asked to assist with writing a white paper about the return on investment (ROI) of bike/walk trails. The whitepaper approach will be confirmed with the Sec. Of Transporation as a helpful approach before proceeding.
- Global Internet Hub (GIH)
 - o The GO Virginia subgrantee reassignment is still in progress. Once the DocuSign is completed, invoices will be sent to the matching donors.
 - o A GO Virginia budget change request will be submitted. PBMares is being consulted for grant management accounting-related suggestions.
 - The City of Virginia Beach has offered a team to create a map digital of assets.
 - o Two other studies will be used as part of the planning strategy:
 - VEDP data center ROI study
 - Hampton Roads Alliance data center study
 - o Greg Gilligan has generated great GIH-related media coverage to date, including the Virtual Innovation Spotlight, which has increased in popularity this year.
 - The next virtual GIH Steering Committee Meeting is Nov. 29.
- Passenger Rail Service Update
 - o RVA757 Connects' Strategic Rail Plan will be presented at the December 13 Board/MIC meeting.
- Support Directors' / MIC Members' Initiatives
 - o Jefferson Lab Supercomputing Support Letter was approved by the EC at the last meeting. This letter will be shared at the December 13 Board/MIC meeting.
