# RVA757 Connects' 2023 Goals & Action Plan – January 2023 Now with Performance Assessment for Year-end 2023

This document (in black type below) are the goals and related action plan for RVA757 Connects' 2023 scope of work <u>as presented to the Executive Committee (EC) in January 2023</u>. As 2023 comes to a close, RVA757 Connects' staff has provided information on our progress on each goal. This staff input is detailed in **red** below.



## RVA757 Connects staff's comments on each specific goal follows:

1. <u>Priority Focus Areas:</u> Advance the board-approved priority focus areas.

The Directors and MIC Members gave RVA757 Connects a 98% top two box rating in advancing RVA757 Connects' signature priorities in 2023:



• I-64 Gap: Help secure remaining funds. Keep positive attention and buzz associated with the overall initiative. Note, several Op Eds now attacking the I-64 Gap.

## Mission accomplished. Groundbreaking took place in November!

- Global Internet Hub: Create the GIH strategic plan.
  - o Complete the GO Virginia grant
  - Tie into Administration and Virginia's 2024 state budget
  - o Promote the plan



Global Internet Hub Strategic Plan was completed by the 60-plus-person Steering Committee and approved by the EC.

RVA757 Connects, as the GO Virginia planning grant grantee, raised the matching funds and completed all of the GO Virginia administrative responsibilities.

Global Internet Hub Strategic Plan was packaged as a full report, Executive Summary, and handout Map. We obtained a grant from Meta to produce the Map. Global Internet Hub Strategic Plan was showcased at Convergence 2023.

In 2023, we stood up the Global Internet Hub Council, a new subcommittee of RVA757 Connects. The core members, along with the Hampton Roads Community Foundation, have pledged \$119K to jump start the work of the Council.

Working with RVA757 Connects' Government Relations Committee, RVA757 Connects' staff sent a comprehensive "Budget Suggestions Document" to the Administration (to four Secretaries) for Virginia's 2024 state budget.

We identified and packaged a concept to give the Global Internet Hub initiative a soul – PCs for People. We convened companies and governments around this concept. Everyone is ready for the next step. In early 2024, we will introduce the CEO of PCs for People to RVA and 757 leaders.

Lastly, we proactively reached out to the Department of Housing and Community Development DHCD to see if our Global Internet Hub Strategic Plan and/or PCs for People initiative would qualify for DHCD funding. Virginia is about to receive \$1.2 billion in federal funding for Universal Broadband Access. DHCD will distribute these funds. We are meeting with DHCD this coming week. Preliminary conversations with DHCD have been promising.

Bike/walk Trails: Follow RVA757 Connects' plan. Advance a Smart Scale-like approach – create a whitepaper. Support HRPDC and the HR Trail Alliance (Tom Cosgrove as champion). Secure funds from VDOT.

We created a Bike-Walk Plan in late 2022. We followed the EC-approved plan. We met with officials from VDOT's newly created State Trails Office. We encouraged the Secretary and Commissioner. Our conclusion - this Administration is not convinced that bike/walk trails are worthy of investment.

We are now deploying our I-64 Gap advocacy approach, creating a "call to arms white paper/report" and convening and collaborating with partners (Sports Backers, HRPDC, Tidewater Trails Alliance, and others).



We are now leading the development of a white paper that makes a strong ROI case for intercity, long-distance bike trails. Our partners are providing input. The paper will be finished by the end of 2023. We will use this paper in early 2024 with the General Assembly and create communication materials for our 2024 bike-walk advocacy work.

Passenger Rail: Follow RVA757 Connects' plan.

We followed the 2022 RVA757 Connects' EC-approved passenger rail plan.

This included forming a planning relationship in 2023 with Virginia Passenger Rail Authority (VPRA) and the Department of Rail and Public Transportation (DRPT).

We brought together three planning district commissions (Plan RVA, HRPDC/HRTPO, and Crater District) for meetings with VPRA and DRPT. It is important to note that RVA757 Connects was the convener.

We supported VPRA's successful federal grant request for Franconia-Springfield Rail Bypass Project. It was awarded \$100 million.

We had VPRA attend our board meeting and Convergence 2023.

We were invited by Virginians for High-Speed Rail to be part of its 2024 rail advocacy plan document. This document is now being sent to every General Assembly member.

This week, major rail investments were announced – all Long Bridge funding is now in place, more rail in I-64 Corridor, and higher-speed rail to Raleigh is advanced (\$1 Billion).

 Advance 4 Target Industry Clusters: Life Sciences/Pharma, Logistics/Transportation, Cyber/National Security, and Data/Analytics.

We featured these four industry clusters throughout 2023 in RVA757 Connects' meetings, Innovation Spotlight webinars, and Convergence 2023.

This is perhaps one area where we can further improve in 2024 with more specific plans and resources for each cluster.

- Jefferson Lab was awarded the funds from General Assembly for the shell building and won the Department of Energy contract for a new High Performance Data Facility.
- Franconia-Springfield Rail Bypass Project was awarded \$100 million.
- 757 Collab received \$1.5 million grant.

RVA757 Connects wrote support letters for all of these initiatives.

- **4. I-64 Innovation Brand:** Showcase innovation and collaboration in the I-64 Innovation Corridor.
  - Continue to ramp-up all communications

Outreach increased. Frequency of communication increased.

  Foundation for a greater Richmond to do the same. They are hyperfocused on and are leading RVA's visioning work.

MIC Co-chairs worked on #6. This is an area for additional work in 2024.

It should be noted that the MIC was more satisfied in 2023 than in 2022 according to the 2023 year-end survey findings.

The Convergence 2023 attended by and featuring some of the MIC was successful – record attendance and sponsorships.

Directors and MIC members gave RVA757 Connects a 91% top two box score in partnerships.

9. Organizational Structure: Spinout RVA757 Connects organization from SIR.

To date, SIR has donated six figures in in-kind professional services, free office space, and use of support services (computers, phones, and copy machines). This support is well-documented. RVA757 Connects' employees and related benefits have been paid by SIR and reimbursed with no markup. In 2023, RVA757 Connects will be more clearly separated from SIR.

- Rollout RVA757 Connects from SIR This is on track.
  - o RVA757 Connects' payroll and benefits are now handled by and through **RVA757 Connects.**
  - Independent IT company now supports RVA757 Connects directly.
  - Computers are owned by RVA757 Connects.
  - SIR still provides free rent and copy machine use.
- Set up benefits and payroll process accomplished
- Set up SIR 2023 contract in place accomplished
- Create RVA757 Connects employee handbook (work with Governance and Nomination Committee) accomplished
- Create RVA757 Connects operating policy handbook (work with Governance and Nomination Committee) - Pushed to 2024
- Implement outcome of MIC planning Ongoing
- We also upgraded our financial accounting system Moved / upgraded to QuickBooks 2.0 for non-profit accounting and worked very closely with PBMares.

While RVA757 Connects is further separating from SIR, SIR still contributed significantly to RVA757 Connects in 2023 that was above and beyond the contracted time. A final memo report will be provided to the EC in late December 2023 that documents SIR's total 2023 financial contribution.

10. What's Next: Identify and promote the big picture on how to make the I-64 Innovation Corridor both RVA and the 757 regions – more competitive over time.

The last Board meeting's generative topic was dedicated to this overall topic- what's next. We need to build on this in 2024.


