Approve June 16th and June 30th EC Minutes

Nomination Committee: Update on Current BOD Recruitment Status

RVA757 Connects' Letter of Support for the BoAT/Capital Trail Extension Project

John Martin shared that an RVA757 Connects' letter of support was emailed with RAISE grant materials for the BoAT/Virginia Capital Trail extension project.

Biden Infrastructure Bill Update

James Spore shared his insights about possible outcomes for the Biden Infrastructure Bill allocation. A general discussion was held about the next steps for the Hampton Roads region. One issue is Hampton Roads not receiving "credit" for the recent \$5.2 billion in transportation infrastructure investment.

White Paper on Making I-64 Innovation Corridor a Top 15 Global Internet Hub

The white paper on Making the I-64 Innovation Corridor a **Top 15 Global Internet Hub** was provided as part of this EC meeting. EC members were not asked to read this but to have it in hand as the paper was explained.

John Martin explained that this topic could be, in fact, transformational for the megaregion (both RVA and the 757) and is perhaps THE very best case for why we need to work together.



John further explained that this is a first draft of a research paper that was put together by SIR. The immediate next step that's underway is to share this paper with the experts SIR interviewed to inform the paper's direction and initial conclusions. This includes obtaining feedback from Virginia Beach and Henrico County economic development representatives.

Once finalized, this whitepaper will be featured as part of RVA757 Connects-CIVIC's October 1st webinar and the Chambers' October 27th Convergence 2021 event. This paper could also serve as the basis of a GO Virginia grant request coming out of the I-64 Innovation Corridor Talent Pipeline Study.

Early suggestions from EC members included sharing the "approved" paper, when it is ready for public dissemination, with:

- VEDP
- The Virginia Chamber of Commerce (Blueprint Virginia 2030)
- The gubernatorial candidates
- RVA757 Connects' Full Board and MIC

Next Steps:

- Discuss the whitepaper's potential and next steps at future EC meetings (everyone was asked to read the paper by July 28)
- Finalize the paper based on experts' feedback
- Share the paper widely
- Incorporate the paper into the RVA757 Connects-CIVIC's October 1st webinar and the Chambers' October 27th Convergence 2021 event
